Exam Highlights

- Exam Mode: Offline, pen-and-paper-based test.
- Duration: 90 minutes.
- Sections: English Language, Logical Reasoning, and Current Affairs & General Knowledge for UG candidates. The LLM exam includes a mix of objective and subjective questions from core law subjects.
