Latest Updates on CLAT 2025

- The final answer key and CLAT 2025 results were declared on 7th December, 2024. Click here to check the results.
- The objection portal is now open.
- CLAT 2025 Provisional Answer Key is out now!
- CLAT 2025 Results will be declared on December 10, 2024.
- The final answer key for CLAT 2025 will be available on the CLAT Consortium's website on December 9, 2024.
- The provisional answer key for CLAT 2025 will be available on the Consortium website on December 2, 4 PM. Students can file their objections on the portal between December 2, 4 PM- December 3, 4 PM.
- Exam concluded at 4 PM and the provisional answer key is to be released soon.
- The CLAT 2025 exam started at 2 PM. It will be over at 4 PM.

What are the students saying?

- The first reaction is that while the paper was easier than previous years, it was lengthy and that increased the difficulty level.
- Overall, CLAT 2025 UG Question Paper's difficulty level was between easy to medium.
- The questions were mostly passage-based.
- The Current Affairs section was medium in terms of difficulty, legal reasoning was between easy to medium. Logical Reasoning was passage-based and not very difficult except one question on seating arrangement. Quantitative Techniques was slightly difficult for some.

Communication from the CLAT Consortium for CLAT 2025

The Consortium of National Law Universities (CNLUs) successfully conducted the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) 2025 across 141 centers in 25 states and 4 union territories. The exam saw a record participation rate, with 96.36% of undergraduate and 92.13% of postgraduate applicants appearing.

CLAT Consortium has published a **notification** detailing how PWDs/SAPs will be accommodated and provided reasonable support. The Consortium has further stated that scribes are allowed for

visually impaired persons provided they meet the conditions put forth by the CLAT Consortium.

The condition states that- “Any scribes must meet the qualification criteria for scribes set out in the Consortium’s Guidelines for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (“PwDs”) / Specially Abled Persons (“SAPs”)”.
