4. (a) Angle covered by hour hand in 12 hours = 360 degrees

Angle covered by hour hand in 3 hours 15 minutes i.e. $13/4$ hours = $[(360/12) * (13/4)]$
= $(195/2)^\circ$

1. (b)

$(360/12) * 7 = 210^\circ$

1. (b)

Angle traced by hour hand at 10 pm = $(360/12) * 10 = 300^\circ$

Angle traced by minute hand in 15 min = $(360/60) * 15 = 90^\circ$

Required angle = 210°

1. (b)

Angle traced by hour hand at 2:30 pm = $(360/12) * (5/2) = 75^\circ$

Angle traced by minute hand in 30 min = $(360/60) * 30 = 180^\circ$

Required angle = 105 degrees

1. (a)

2. (b)

$$(360/12) * 6 = 180^\circ$$

1. (d)

$$\text{Angle traced by hour hand at 7 pm} = (360/12) * 7 = 210^\circ$$

$$\text{Angle traced by minute hand in 20 min} = (360/60) * 20 = 120^\circ$$

$$\text{Required angle} = 90^\circ$$

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
