Try to make a list month-wise by listing the case name, Bench, and ratio decidendi of the case. Analyze the cases and this can help you understand and grasp the foundational principles of law. Understanding past cases can also be particularly beneficial for CLAT PG, as it can help you answer questions related to legal principles, judgments, and case laws effectively.

## **TIP 2- List all major amendments in laws in the last 2-3 years**

Laws are constantly evolving, and staying up-to-date with the latest legal amendments ensures that you have a current understanding of the legal framework. This is crucial for academic success and professional practice. CLAT PG may include questions related to recent legal amendments.

Being aware of these changes can help you answer questions accurately and efficiently during the exam. To effectively study the latest legal amendments for CLAT PG 2024, make use of official legal sources, government publications, legal databases, and academic materials.

Few recent amendments are UAPA (Amendment) Act, 2019, RTI (Amendment) Act, 2019, Digital Personal Data Protection Bill, 2023, Latest amendments to CrPC, IPC etc.
