- Germany hosts G7 – 48th edition of G7.– Presidency is held by Germany.– Countries invited: Argentina, India, Indonesia, Senegal, South Africa.– G7, formed in 1975.– G7 includes UK, Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, US– Till 1975, it was the Group of 6. Canada was invited to join in 1976.
- NATO Nations sign protocols to onboard Sweden, Finland – 30 NATO allies signed accession protocols.– NATO: North Atlantic Treaty Organisation.– Established by the Washington Treaty of 1949. – Headquarters: Brussels, Belgium.– 13th Secretary-General: Jens Stoltenberg

- Charles Leclerc wins Austrian Grand Prix
- Ferrari's Charles Leclerc won the Austrian GP.
- Against Red Bull's Max Verstappen.
- Formula 1 Motor race
- Held at Red Bull Ring in Spielberg, Austria.

- Ex-PM Shinzo Abe awarded Collar of the Supreme Order of the Chrysanthemum Awarded posthumously. – Longest-serving PM of Japan. – Collar of the Supreme Court of the Chrysanthemum: Japan's highest order. – Shinzo Abe was assassinated while campaigning in the city of Nara. – India awarded him with the Padma Vibhushan in 2021.

- India's 1st AI Lok Adalat – State: Rajasthan. – Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority.– Launched by the then Chairman of NALSA: Uday Umesh Lalit. – Designed by Jupitice Justice Technologies.– NALSA: constituted under Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987. – Headquarters: New Delhi. – AI helps in disposing pending cases fast.
- New MD of National Stock Exchange – New MD and CEO: Ashishkumar Chauhan– Term: 5 years.– Former MD and CEO: Vikram Lamaye– Year of incorporation of NSE: 1992– Chairperson: Girish Chandra Chaturvedi– Headquarters: Mumbai

- Draupadi Murmu, India's 15th President – 2nd woman to hold this post.– 1st Female President of India: Pratibha Patil.– Former President: Ram Nath Kovind.– First tribal woman to hold this office.– Candidate of National Democratic Alliance(NDA).– Former Governor of Jharkhand.
