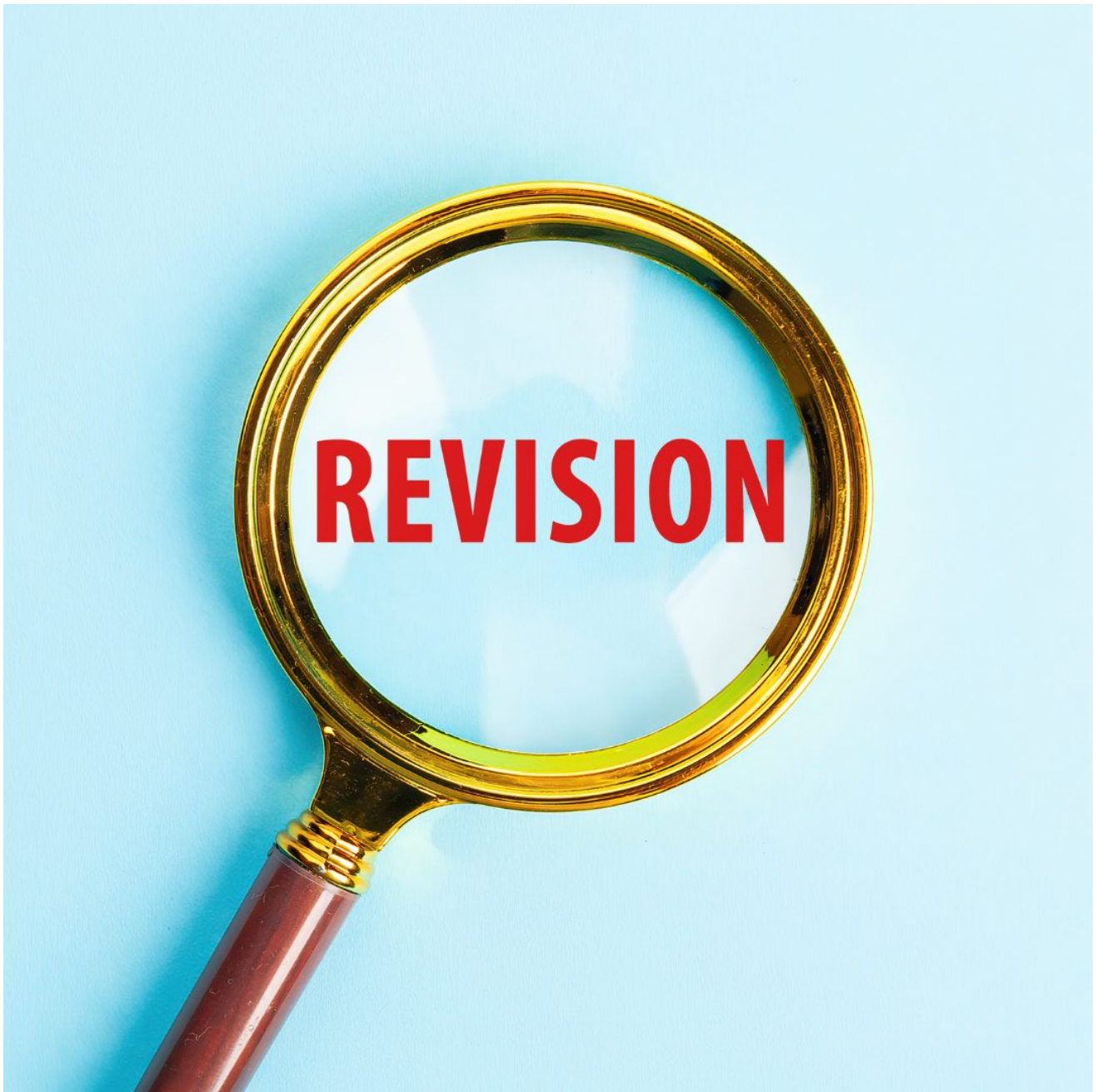
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Last Minute Preparation Tips for CLAT 2026

2. Don't focus on pending subjects/ topics a lot



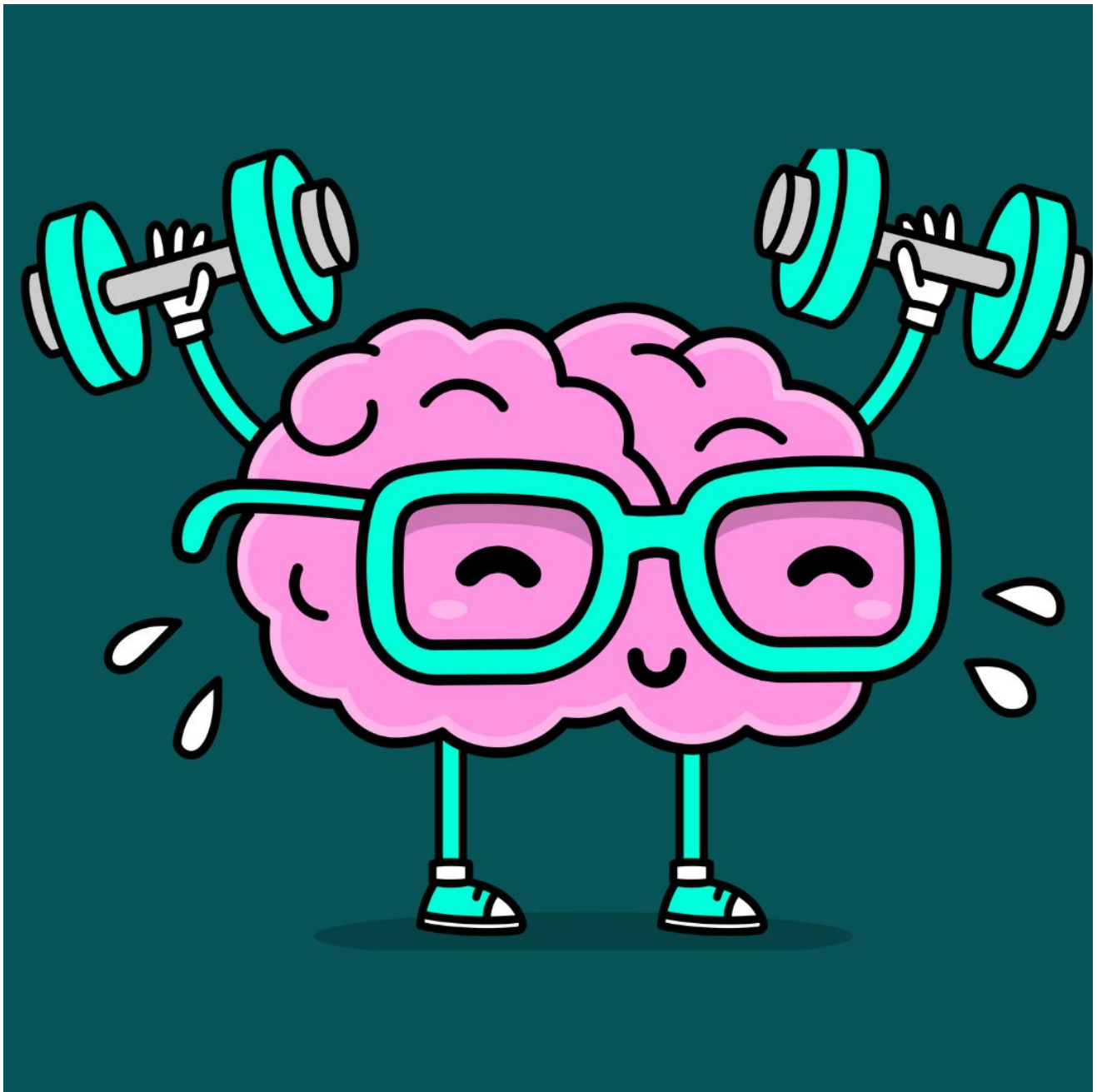
Try to use the remaining time to build upon your strength. You can of course take a look at the pending topics and try and cover the most important ones; however, our advice would be to play to your strengths.

For example, questions based on legal reasoning are more likely to be solved via the most practical approach. There are tricky questions that are meant to make you nervous; however, the answer can be found by focusing on the legal principle given in the passage.

Note: On the eve of the exam, organize your essentials – admit card, ID, pens, and other required materials. Plan your route to the exam center, and ensure you have ample time to reach there without rushing.
