Answers

1. Correct Answer: B – Banning plastic bags will not substantially curb pollution because the primary source of major pollution is industry. Consequently, the other available options fail to directly refute this claim.
2. Correct Answer: B – East and west cancel out. Only 8 km north remains.
3. Correct Answer: C – The argument works only if people actually change their mode of transport. Other options do not ensure congestion reduction.
4. Correct Answer: A – Each letter is shifted one step forward in the alphabet.
5. Correct Answer: C – Financial inclusion is fundamentally about having access to banking services. Option C is the most direct supporting statement for this concept, while the other options are either indirectly related or not relevant.
6. Correct Answer: C – initial number +5, +7, +9 → next +11 → $23 + 11 = 34$.
7. Correct Answer: B – The implementation of stricter rules appears to be effective, as evidenced by the subsequent rise in participation. Alternative explanations are not supported and would rely on assumptions.
8. Correct Answer: A – Order becomes D – B – A – C – E. A is in the middle.
9. Correct Answer: C – The statement after “therefore” is the conclusion.
10. Correct Answer: B – Eye is used for seeing; ear is used for hearing.
11. Correct Answer: B – Misinformation reduces awareness. Other options support or are irrelevant.
12. Correct Answer: B – North and south cancel; only 5 km west remains.
13. Correct Answer: B – Lack of challenge does not prove correctness.

14. Correct Answer: D – Mango is a fruit; others are flowers.
15. Correct Answer: C – Flexibility directly improves work-life balance, leading to higher morale.
