Answers

1. Correct Answer: B - Online exams are ineffective at preventing cheating if students can use multiple devices. Options A and C are irrelevant to the argument's validity, while option D actually supports it.
2. Correct Answer: A East and west cancel. Net south movement = $5 - 2 = 3$ km south.
3. Correct Answer: B - The core condition for this argument's validity is that people must utilize the parks; other supporting factors are helpful but not essential.
4. Correct Answer: A Each letter shifts alternately: +1, +2 pattern $L \rightarrow M (+1)$ $O \rightarrow P (+1)$ $G \rightarrow H (+1)$ $I \rightarrow J (+1)$ $C \rightarrow D (+1)$ (Uniform +1 shift) $\rightarrow$ MPHJD
5. Correct Answer: A - Focus is enhanced, and output is improved by reducing stress. The other choices provided do not support the claim and are either neutral or detract from it.
6. Correct Answer: C $\times 2 + 1$ pattern $47 \times 2 + 1 = 95$
7. Correct Answer: B - The observation that a decline occurred after the inspections strongly suggests the inspections were effective; other interpretations are either too strong or lack supporting evidence.
8. Correct Answer: C Arrangement: S - R - P - Q - T So, T is at the extreme right.
9. Correct Answer: C - The recommendation after "hence" is the conclusion.
10. Correct Answer: C - Courts deliver justice; hospitals provide treatment.
11. Correct Answer: A - Misinformation diminishes awareness; other factors either reinforce it or are unrelated.
12. Correct Answer: A - North and south cancel. Only 6 km east remains.
13. Correct Answer: A - Old practices are not necessarily correct.
14. Correct Answer: D - Freedom is a concept; others are systems of governance.
15. Correct Answer: B - Reduced commuting time directly contributes to a better work-life balance; the other choices do not establish this clear, causal link.
