Answers

1. Correct Answer: B

The argument suggests that increased CCTV surveillance in public spaces will not substantially decrease overall crime because the majority of crimes occur in private settings. Options C and D serve to strengthen this claim, while Option A, concerning cost, is irrelevant to the surveillance's effectiveness.

2. Correct Answer: A

North and south cancel out. Only 6 km west remains.

3. Correct Answer: C

Effective monitoring is essential for preventing cheating in online exams. Options A, B, and D are not directly relevant to controlling cheating.

4. Correct Answer: A

Each letter is shifted +1:

S→T, O→P, U→V, L→M = **TPVM**

5. Correct Answer: B

Reducing stress has a direct, positive impact on mental well-being. The other options (A, C, and D) do not demonstrate a clear benefit to mental health.

6. Correct Answer: C

+6, +8, +10 → next +12

29 + 12 = **41**

7. Correct Answer: C

The decrease in malpractice logically suggests that invigilation efforts have been effective. Options A and B lack supporting evidence, while Option D is an overstatement.

8. Correct Answer: B

Arrangement: **R - Q - P - T - S**

P is third (middle).

9. Correct Answer: C

The statement after "therefore" is always the conclusion. Others are premises.

10. Correct Answer: B

A doctor works in a hospital; a teacher works in a school.

11. Correct Answer: B

The claim is weakened by distractions, as they decrease productivity. Options A and D support the claim, while Option C is not relevant.

12. Correct Answer: B

East and west cancel; only 4 km south remains.

13. Correct Answer: B

Just because many people follow something doesn't make it fair. Others don't match the reasoning pattern.

14. Correct Answer: D

Eraser removes writing; others are used to write.

15. Correct Answer: C

The increased number of visits is a direct consequence of the improved facilities resulting from the renovation. Options A and B are merely assumptions. Option D would have the opposite effect, leading to a decrease in footfall.
