Logical Reasoning Questions for CLAT 2025

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1. Statement: "All cats are mammals. Some mammals are lions."

Conclusion:

- i) Some lions are cats.
- ii) All cats are lions.

- a) Only i follows
- b) Only ii follows
- c) Both follow
- d) Neither follows

Answer: d) Neither follows

Explanation: No direct relationship between cats and lions can be deduced.

2. Identify the assumption:

Statement: "Online education is better than traditional education."

- a) Everyone has internet access.
- b) Online education is more flexible.
- c) Traditional education is less effective.
- d) Both a and b.

Answer: b) Online education is more flexible.

Explanation: The statement assumes online education's benefits, particularly flexibility.

3. Statement: "Some fruits are apples. All apples are sweet."

Conclusion:

- ii) All sweet things are apples.

Explanation: The statement assumes bonuses act as a motivator.

- c) Health cannot improve without exercise.
- d) Only healthy people exercise.

Answer: b) Regular exercise improves health.

Explanation: The statement implies a positive link between exercise and health.

8. Statement: "No smartphones are completely secure."

Conclusion:

- i) Some secure devices are smartphones.
 - ii) All smartphones are insecure.
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- a) Only i follows
 - b) Only ii follows

Answer: b) Only ii follows

Explanation: The statement directly implies that no smartphone is secure.

9. Statement: "If it rains, the match will be canceled."

Conclusion:

Answer: a) Only i follows
