6. A newspaper publishes private medical details of a celebrity without consent. The celebrity sues. Which principle is most relevant?

Answer: B

Explanation: Publication of private details without consent violates the Right to Privacy.

7. Premises:

- No realist is a dreamer.

Answer: B

Answer: C
