SLAT is a prestigious entrance test for admission into Symbiosis Law School, which falls under Symbiosis International University. There are a total of 4 campuses of these universities, in which admission can be taken- Pune, Hyderabad, Noida and Nagpur.

The test is of the objective kind, with multiple-choice answers. Because there is no negative marking system, students must answer all the questions. There are 60 questions in all, and students must finish the test in two and a half hours.

- English – Reading Comprehension
- Analytical Reasoning
- Legal Reasoning
- General Knowledge
- Logical Reasoning

Preparation Tips for SLAT 2023

Here are a few pointers I utilized when studying for the SLAT.

a) Get familiar with the test format and question types: Examine the syllabus carefully. Learn about the scoring system and the weightage of each component.

b) Create a study schedule:

- o Break the material into small sections.
- o Establish daily and weekly goals that are attainable.
- o Make a study schedule and stick to it.
- o Make some time for revision.

c) Take practice tests:

- o Make an effort to take as many practice examinations as feasible.
- o Receive feedback on your performance and identify areas for improvement.
- o Practice answering questions in the allotted time.

d) Concentrate on your weak points:

- o Determine your weak points and work to improve them.
- o Make an effort to practice as many questions as possible from these categories.
- o Pay close attention to the principles in these areas.

e) Increase your speed and accuracy:

- o Concentrate on increasing your speed and accuracy.
- o Practice answering questions in the allotted time.
- o Make an effort to answer all of the questions.

f) Stress management:

- o Take frequent pauses and get enough rest.
- o Workout on a regular basis and eat a nutritious diet.
- o To keep motivated, talk to your friends and family.

g) Revision is the key!

- o Make a point of reviewing all you've learned.
- o Examine all of your notes and practice sheets.
- o Take special attention to grasp things with which you are unfamiliar.

How to prepare for SLAT 2023 PI-WAT?

If you are shortlisted after taking the SLAT, you will be required to take the PI-WAT. The PI-WAT is the second round of admission. This is the fundamental personality evaluation stage, which includes group discussions, essay writing, and a personal interview. The topic of the essay is not disclosed ahead of time, and they want to assess your originality, writing abilities, critical thinking, and so on. Group discussions are used to assess your communication abilities and confidence. The trick to solving this is to utter a few but impactful words. Careful not to be overly forceful.

Additionally, don't just sit there; speak out if you have an opinion. Say anything you want, but ensure that there's a clear logical sense to your statements. To be able to make balanced statements, you should be informed of what is going on in the globe. To prepare specifically for this round, I read a lot of newspapers and tried to analyze things from a neutral and holistic perspective.

How to prepare for SLAT 2023 Interview Round?

The interview is the third round. It's generally quite simple, with questions about you, your interests, and other such things. You can Google the most often requested interview questions. However, my personal suggestion is to be prepared with a few notes on who you are, why you're interested in pursuing law and why you'd be a good fit for the institution. Along with that, you can also keep handy a set of instances that increased your inclination towards law as a profession.

Which subject requires more time in SLAT?

SLAT requires you to prepare mostly for General Knowledge and Legal Aptitude, since you will be dealing with situations based on Principles and Facts. Hence, you should concentrate on current events and keep in mind that reading the news/pointers is not enough; you must also collect background material, additional data, historical events connected to the present event, and so on in order to have a 360-degree view of an issue. Static GK or General Knowledge questions that are directly or indirectly relevant to Current Affairs are often asked.

Along with that, I'd advise you to work more on reading-comprehension the most since that would help you attempt other sections with utmost ease and accuracy.
