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Questions on Seating Arrangement for CLAT; Answers Explained with Pictures!

Entrance exams like CLAT, LSAT etc are designed to analyse the aptitude of a candidate. The section relating to Logical Reasoning, specifically, helps judge the reasoning capabilities of a student.

This section can be aced by practicing numerous questions to familiarise oneself with types of questions and the techniques best suited for them. In Logical Reasoning, questions relating to seating arrangement are fairly common.

Here is a quick practice test:

- There is one student Ashima (not male) sitting between Akshay and Arushi, on the left of Akshay.
- The person sitting immediately to the left of Arushi and immediately to the right of Aashi is a male.
- From the right side of Akshay, there is just one person (male) sitting between Abhilash and Akshay.
- The person sitting between Abhilash and Ashima is a female.
