Sectional Test on Interrogation under BNSS, 2023 for CLAT PG

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Police interrogation under BNSS, 2023, is mentioned under **sections 179-183**, and it governs the examination of witnesses and accused during the investigation. **Article 20(3)** of the Constitution of India protects the accused from self-incrimination during the process of self-incrimination.

Under BNSS, 2023, it is mandatory for the audio-video recording of confessions and statements before a judicial magistrate under **section 183 of BNSS, 2023**. This reinforces fair trial and constitutional safeguards under **Articles 20 and 21** of the Constitution of India.
