1. Correct Answer: D Total = $25 \times 48 = 1200$ First 10 = 420 Last 10 = 520 Remaining = $1200 - 940 = 260$ Average = $260/5 = 52$
2. Correct Answer: B Amount after 3 years = 9600 Amount after 5 years = 10800 Difference = 1200 (interest for 2 years) 1 yr interest = 600 Principal = $9600 - (3 \times 600) = ₹7800$
3. Correct Answer: B Numbers = 4×6 , 7×6 Larger = 42
4. Correct Answer: C Relative speed = $72 - 54 = 18 \text{ km/h} = 5 \text{ m/s}$ Total length = 400 m Time = $400 / 5 = 80 \text{ sec}$
5. Correct Answer: B CP of 15 = SP of 12 SP/CP = $15/12$ Profit = 25%
6. Correct Answer: B $100 \rightarrow 120$ $120 \rightarrow 108$ $108 \rightarrow 135$ Increase = 35%
7. Correct Answer: A $(7/20) \times (6/19) = 42/380 = 21/190$
8. Correct Answer: C Water increase = 3 parts = 24 1 part = 8 Total parts = 12 Mixture = $12 \times 8 = 96 \text{ L}$
9. Correct Answer: A Difference = 5 parts = 45 1 part = 9 Larger = $11 \times 9 = 99$
10. Correct Answer: B Downstream = $30/2 = 15$ Upstream = $30/3 = 10$ Stream = $(15 - 10)/2 = 2.5 \text{ km/h}$
11. Correct Answer: A $1.25 \times 0.80 = 1$ Area same (no change).
12. Correct Answer: B Total = $18 \times 36 = 648$ Remove = 90 Remaining = 558 Average = $558/16 = 34.875$
13. Correct Answer: B CP = 100 MP = 150 After 20% discount $\rightarrow 120$ Profit = 20%
14. Correct Answer: C Area $\propto r^2$ $(1.3)^2 = 1.69$ Increase = 69%
15. Correct Answer: B Let ages = 5x, 6x $(5x+4)/(6x+4) = 6/7$ $x = 4$ A = $5 \times 4 = 24$
