Q1. The marked price of an item in a shop is ₹1,600. The shopkeeper offers a 20% discount on this price, still achieves a 25% profit. Determine the original cost price of the article.

Q15. A shopkeeper buys 8 pens for ₹120 and sells all of them for ₹160. What is the profit percentage earned by him?

Answers & Explanations

1. Correct Answer: B

Discounted SP = 80% of 1600 = 1280

1280 = 125% of CP

CP = $1280/1.25 = \text{₹}1000$

2. Correct Answer: C

Let speed = x

$360/x - 360/(x + 20) = 2$

Solving gives x = **60 km/h**

3. Correct Answer: B

Total ratio parts = 7 + 5 = 12

Girls = $(5/12) \times 1440 = \text{600}$

4. Correct Answer: D

Total (wrong) = $8 \times 64 = 512$

Excess added = $84 - 54 = 30$

Correct total = $512 - 30 = 482$

Correct average = $482 \div 8 = \text{62}$

5. Correct Answer: C

Original total = $5 \times 26 = 130$

New total = $6 \times 28 = 168$

Age of new member = $168 - 130 = \text{38 years}$

6. Correct Answer: B

Breadth = x, Length = 2x

Perimeter = $2(3x) = 120 \rightarrow x = 20$

Area = $20 \times 40 = 800$ sq cm

7. Correct Answer: A

After increase = $60,000 \times 1.15 = 69,000$

After decrease = $69,000 \times 0.8 = 55,200$

8. Correct Answer: C

Total balls = $7 + 5 + 8 = 20$

Red balls = 8

Probability = **8/20**

9. Correct Answer: C

Average of 10 numbers = 50

Total of the 10 numbers = $10 \times 50 = 500$

One number is replaced by another number which is **30 more** than the original.

So, the total sum increases by 30.

New total = $500 + 30 = 530$

New average = $530 \div 10 = 53$

10. Correct Answer: B

Expenses = 80%

Savings = 20% = 4,000

Income = $4,000 \times 100/20 = 4,000 \times 5 = \text{₹}25,000$

11. Correct Answer: A

Distance covered = 90 km

Time taken = 6 hours

Speed = Distance/Time = $90/6 = 15$ km/h

To convert km/h to m/s:

1 km/h = $5/18$ m/s

Speed in m/s = $15 \times 5/18 = 75/18 = 25/6$ m/s = **4.17 m/s**

12. Correct Answer: D

Let the two numbers be **5x** and **9x**.

Difference between the numbers = $9x - 5x = 4x$

Given difference = 72

So, $4x = 72$

$$x = 18$$

$$\text{Larger number} = 9x = 9 \times 18 = \mathbf{162}$$

13. Correct Answer: C

$$\text{Net change} = +20 - 10 - (20 \times 10)/100 = 10 - 2 = \mathbf{8\% \text{ increase}}$$

14. Correct Answer: B

$$6 \times 20 = 10 \times x$$

$$120 = 10x$$

$$x = \mathbf{12 \text{ days}}$$

15. Correct Answer: D

$$\text{Cost price} = ₹120$$

$$\text{Selling price} = ₹160$$

$$\text{Profit} = 160 - 120 = ₹40$$

$$\text{Profit \%} = (\text{Profit/Cost Price}) \times 100 = (40 \div 120) \times 100 = 1/3 \times 100 = \mathbf{33\frac{1}{3}\%}$$
