Answers

1. Correct Answer: A Total = $12 \times 28 = 336$ Known = $(5 \times 20 + 4 \times 32) = 220$ Remaining sum = 116
Remaining numbers = 3 Average = $116/3 = 30$

2. Correct Answer: D

1 year interest = $7200 - 6600 = 600$

4 years interest = 2400

Principal = $7200 - 2400 = \text{₹}6000$

3. Correct Answer: B

Difference = 2 parts = 30

1 part = 15

Larger = $9 \times 15 = 135$

4. Correct Answer: C

Let speed = x

$240/x - 240/(x+20) = 2$

x = **60 km/h**

5. Correct Answer: C

Let CP per item = 1

CP of 18 = 18

SP per item = $18/15 = 1.2$

Profit = **20%**

6. Correct Answer: B

$1.25 \times 0.8 = 1$

No change

7. Correct Answer: C

Total balls = 20

Blue = 6

Probability = $6/20 = 3/10$

8. Correct Answer: A

Water increases from 4 parts to 7 parts → increase = 3 parts

3 parts = 12 litres → 1 part = 4 litres

Original parts = $5 + 4 = 9$

Original quantity = $9 \times 4 = 36$ litres

9. Correct Answer: B

Total parts = 13

1 part = 7

Smaller = $4 \times 7 = 28$

10. Correct Answer: A

Downstream = 10 km/h

Upstream = 6 km/h

Stream = $(10 - 6) / 2 = 2$ km/h

11. Correct Answer: C

Area ↑ = $(1.1)^2 - 1 = 21\%$

12. Correct Answer: B

Total = $15 \times 18 = 270$

Known = $(5 \times 16 + 5 \times 20) = 180$

Remaining sum = 90

Average = $90 / 5 = 18$

13. Correct Answer: C

30% = 9000

Income = $9000 \times 100 / 30 = ₹30,000$

14. Correct Answer: C

Area ↑ = $(1.2)^2 - 1 = 44\%$

15. Correct Answer: B

Let ages = 3x and 5x

$(3x + 6) / (5x + 6) = 4 / 6$

x = 8

A = $3 \times 8 = 24$
