Sectional Test on Quantitative Techniques for CLAT UG [Part 1]

Q	Ans	Explanation
1	C	$(6050 - 4600)/4600 \times 100 = 31.52\% \approx 31.5\%$
2	D	Institute E: $(1100-700)/700 \times 100 = 57.14\%$

3	B	$A+B = 2700, D+E = 2400 \rightarrow \text{Ratio} = 9:8$
4	C	$25\% + 25\% = 50\% \text{ of } 120 = 60 \text{ hours}$
5	C	Maths: $18h \rightarrow 27h$ (50% increase) $\rightarrow$ New total = 129h
6	C	Logical: $20\% \times 360^\circ = 72^\circ$
7	C	$\text{₹}500 \rightarrow 20\% \text{ off} = \text{₹}400 \rightarrow +12\% \text{ GST} = \text{₹}448$
8	B	$20 \text{ correct} \times 4 = 80, 5 \text{ wrong} \times (-1) = -5 \rightarrow \text{Total} = 75$
9	B	$5x + 2x = 70 \rightarrow x = 10 \rightarrow \text{Failed} = 2x = 20$
10	C	$(78 + 82 + 85 + 80 + 75)/5 = 80$
