3	D. Banaras Session, 1905	The Swadeshi Movement was formally adopted by the Congress at the Banaras Session in 1905.
4	B. The Hague	The Permanent Court of Arbitration (PCA) is headquartered in The Hague, Netherlands.
5	D. Prime Minister	The President dissolves the Lok Sabha on the advice of the Prime Minister and the Council of Ministers.
