including the Factories Act, Mines Act, Plantations Labour Act, Contract Labour Act etc. (D)

According to Section 32 of the Code, Every worker employed in an establishment shall be entitled for leave in a calendar year with wages if he has worked one hundred and eighty days or more in such calendar year. (C) One major reform feature introduced by the OSH Code is Compounding of

offences under Section 114 of the Code (D) Section 6 of the Code provides for the duties of the

employers (B) According to Section 43 of the Code, women shall be entitled to be employed in all establishments for all types of work and they may also be employed, with their consent before 6

a.m. and beyond 7 p.m. subject to such conditions relating to safety, holidays and working hours or any other condition to be observed by the employer as may be prescribed by the appropriate

Government. (D) Under Section 22 of the Code, the appropriate Government may, by general or special order, require any establishment or class of establishments to constitute in the prescribed

manner a Safety Committee. And the employer shall also appoint such safety officers in every

establishment which is a (a) factory wherein five hundred workers or more; or (b) factory carrying on hazardous process wherein two hundred fifty workers or more; or (c) building or other

construction work wherein two hundred fifty workers or more; or (d) mine wherein one hundred

workers or more, are ordinarily employed. (C) (C) (D) (D) Section 2 (zf) of the Code defines

"inter-State migrant worker". (B) Section 24 of the Code provides for welfare facilities to be

provided by the employer. Facilities of canteen in an establishment for employees shall be

provided wherein one hundred or more workers including contract labourers are ordinarily
