SLAT

SLAT is a prestigious entrance test for admission into Symbiosis Law School, which falls under Symbiosis International University. There are a total of 4 campuses of these universities, in which admission can be taken- Pune, Hyderabad, Noida, and Nagpur.

It is used by law schools in India that offer 5-year LLB, 3-year LLB, and LLM programs. It is primarily a test of reasoning, reading, and critical analysis skills. LSAT in India is usually conducted in two sessions, one in January and one in June.
